creations of virtuosos liszt paganini and chopin among others schumann engaged with
instrumental virtuosity through not only his compositions and performances but also
his music reviews and writings about his contemporaries ultimately the discourse of
virtuosity influenced the culture of western art music well beyond the nineteenth
century and into the present day by examining previously unexplored archival sources
alexander stefaniak looks at the diverse approaches to virtuosity schumann developed
over the course of his career revealing several distinct currents in nineteenth century
german virtuosity and the enduring flexibility of virtuosity discourse

from the great raconteur of the american underworld and author of the gangs of new
york comes sucker s progress an information history of gambling in america from
midwestern riverboats to east coast racetracks herbert asbury explores the legal and
illegal history of gambling in pre wwii america describing notorious gambling havens
like chicago and new orleans as well as lesser known outposts in cities like fort wayne
indiana and cincinnati ohio asbury examines the gambling houses big and small which
peppered the american landscape also presented are the lives of some of america s
most famous gamblers including mike mcdonald john morrissey and richard canfield
as well as their infamous counterparts like canada bill and charley black eyes men who
made their names as grifters and con men asbury also explores the games these men

played describing the rules and origins of dozens of dice and card games from 1 lottery tickets to thousand dollar pokes antes america s love of gambling thrives today but it was during asbury s era that gambling was established as an american passion asbury embarked on what seems in retrospect an extraordinary mission to document the entire underworld of america from new orleans to san francisco his studies of gambling of the racial politics of the new orleans french quarter and of the history of chicago crime remain monuments to an ambition that was then confined to the fringes of pop history sucker s progress his history of gambling and swindling in america is dense with facts about a subject one would have thought persisted only as rumour and tall tale a gopnik the new yorker one of the best american books of its kind he tells the story of the new york underworld of the past century and his narrative is excellently presented in a book adorned with amusing pictures from the weeklies and newspapers e pearson the sat rev of books

dalcroze education is an experiential way of knowing music through the body this dynamic and profound philosophy stems from an oral tradition that can be traced back to those who studied directly with Émile jaques dalcroze in geneva switzerland during his lifetime 1865 1950 recent trends in music education and dalcroze students stated needs have demanded more specificity and accessibility these books aim to meet those needs by providing examples of many important skills necessary for a successful dalcrozian without being narrow or prescriptive dalcroze eurhythmics solfège improvisation plastique animée and pedagogy are all addressed in these volumes with specific skills necessary to earn the internationally recognized dalcroze license students who use these books should already have their dalcroze professional certificate by an authorized dalcroze training center run by someone who holds the diplôme supérieur from the institut jaques dalcroze in geneva switzerland it is my hope that these books will enable individuals to gain access to la méthode jaques dalcroze with more efficiency and facility while maintaining the high standards of musicianship that are required to offer joyful and musically inspiring coursework in dalcroze education

the urban renewal policies stemming from the 1954 housing act and 1956 highway act destroyed the economic centers of many black neighborhoods in the united states struggle for the city recovers the agency and solidarity of african american residents confronting this diagnosis of blight in northern cities in the 1950s and 1960s examining black newspapers archival documents from black organizations and oral histories of community advocates derek g handley shows how african american residents in three communities the hill district of pittsburgh the bronzeville neighborhood of milwaukee and the rondo district of st paul enacted a new form of citizenship to fight for their neighborhoods dubbing this the black rhetorical citizenship a nod to the integral role of language and other symbolic means in the black freedom movement handley situates citizenship as both a site of resistance and a mode of public engagement that cannot be divorced from race and the effects of racism through this framework struggle for the city demonstrates how local organizers leaders and residents used rhetorics of

placemaking community organizing and critical memory to resist the bulldozing visions of urban renewal by showing how african american residents built political community at the local level and by centering the residents in their own narratives of displacement handley recovers strategies of resistance that continue to influence the actions of the black freedom movement including black lives matter

in musical form forms and formenlehre three eminent music theorists reflect on the fundamentals of musical form they discuss how to analyze form in music and question the relevance of analytical theories and methods in general they illustrate their basic concepts and concerns by offering some concrete analyses of works by mozart idomeneo overture jupiter symphony and beethoven first and pastoral symphony egmont overture and die ruinen von athen overture the volume is divided into three parts focusing on caplin's theory of formal functions hepokoski's concept of dialogic form and webster's method of multivalent analysis respectively each part begins with a basic essay by one of the three authors subsequently the two opposing authors comment on issues and analyses they consider to be problematic or underdeveloped in a style that ranges from the gently critical to the overtly polemical finally the author of the initial essay is given the opportunity to reply to the comments and to further refine his own fundamental ideas on musical form

cadence explores the many ways in which the component parts of a classical composition achieve a sense of ending the book examines cadential practice in a wide variety of musical styles in the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries including works by well known composers such as bach mozart beethoven schubert chopin and brahms

building on ideas first advanced by arnold schoenberg and later developed by erwin ratz this book introduces a new theory of form for instrumental music in the classical style the theory provides a broad set of principles and a comprehensive methodology for the analysis of classical form from individual ideas phrases and themes to the large scale organization of complete movements it emphasizes the notion of formal function that is the specific role a given formal unit plays in the structural organization of a classical work

we do not understand music it understands us this aphorism by theodor w adorno expresses the quandary and the fascination many listeners have felt in approaching beethoven s late quartets no group of compositions occupies a more central position in chamber music yet the meaning of these works continues to stimulate debate william kinderman s the string quartets of beethoven stands as the most detailed and comprehensive exploration of the subject it collects new work by leading international scholars who draw on a variety of historical sources and analytical approaches to offer fresh insights into the aesthetics of the quartets probing expressive and structural features that have hitherto received little attention this volume also includes an appendix with updated information on the chronology and sources of the quartets and a detailed bibliography

when franz schubert put goethe s poem gretchen am spinnrade to music in 1814 he created a musical form that has captivated audiences ever since in poetry into song deborah stein and robert spillman challenge readers to seek a richer more imaginative understanding of lied the nineteenth century german art song written for students of voice piano and theory and for all singers and accompanists poetry into song establishes a framework for the analysis of song based on a process of performing listening analyzing and performing again this unique approach emphasizes the reciprocal interaction between performance and analysis focusing on the masterworks poetry into song features numerous poetic texts as well as a core repertory of songs examples throughout the text demonstrate points and end of chapter questions reinforce concepts and encourage directed analysis while numerous books have been written on lieder and german romantic poetry poetry into song is the first to combine performance musical analysis textual analysis and the interrelation between poetry and music in a truly systematic thorough way

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
