applied be that thing and no other in other words the name is that thing s essence or concept what is pointed out by the definition of the name ruler for example is that essence which makes a ruler a ruler in the phrase let the ruler be ruler etc the first word ruler refers to ruler as a material actuality while the second ruler is the name and concept of the ideal ruler take the example of the analogous to a tree we are sitting on a very high branch sometimes we are looking down at the stem beneath us and sometimes not anyways the important and interesting things are in the roots which are
